Tommy Boy

Ryan Braun (33hr/33sb) became just the second player in franchise history to produce a 30/30 season, joining **Tommy Harper**, who had 31 HR and 38 stolen bases in 1970.

The Ax-Man Cometh

John Axford established a new franchise record with 46 saves this season, including an active streak of 43 in a row, another franchise record.

NL CENTRAL CHAMPS: At 96-66, the Brewers established a franchise record for wins in a season as they captured their first ever National League Central championship.....it marked the second division championship in franchise history (1982 - American League East).....2011 marks the fourth postseason appearance ever for the Brewers (1981, 1982, 2008 and 2011).

MANAGER: Ron Roenicke is in his first season as a Major League manager, a position he was named to on 11/4/10, replacing Ken Macha.....he joined the Brewers after 11 seasons on the coaching staff of the Los Angeles Angels of Anaheim, where he served as third-base coach (2000-05) and bench coach (2006-10).....bio is on p. 36 of the media guide.

COACHES: Bullpen coach **Stan Kyles** (3rd season), third-base coach **Ed Sedar** (5th season, 1st as 3B coach) and hitting coach **Dale Sveum** (6th season, 3rd as hitting coach) all returned from the 2010 coaching staff.....new on the staff was first-base coach **Garth Iorg**, pitching coach **Rick Kranitz** and bench coach **Jerry Narron**.

ALL-STARS: For the sixth consecutive season, the Brewers had at least three players selected to the All-Star Game.....the team had three players (Braun, Fielder and Weeks) elected as starters for the first time in franchise history.....**Prince Fielder** was named MVP.

FREE AGENTS (8): The following players will be eligible for free agency at the conclusion of the season: **SS Yuniesky Betancourt**, **INF Craig Counsell**, **1B Prince Fielder**, **INF/OF Jerry Hairston Jr.**, **RHP LaTroy Hawkins**, **1B/OF Mark Kotsay**, **RHP Francisco Rodriguez** and **RHP Takashi Saito**.

ARBITRATION (9): The following players will be eligible for arbitration at the conclusion of the season: **OF Carlos Gomez**, **C George Kottaras**, **RHP Kameron Loe**, **RHP Shaun Marcum**, **3B Casey McGehee**, **OF Nyjer Morgan**, **LHP Manny Parra**, **LHP Mitch Stetter** and **INF Josh Wilson**.

BREWERS AT HOME: The Brewers went 57-24 (.704) at home this season, going 19-6-1 in series play.....their .704 home winning percentage led the Major Leagues.....their 57 home wins marked a new franchise record (54-27 in 1978).....the team had a 9-game winning streak from 5/13-5/25, which is the longest streak ever at Miller Park and tied the second-longest home streak ever (also 4/6-4/26, 1987).....the Brewers also had an 8-game home winning streak from 7/26-8/1 and a 7-game streak from 8/3-8/17 this season.....the team lost consecutive home games for the first time from 7/4-7/5 vs. Arizona and were swept for the only time at home from 8/30-9/1 vs. St. Louis.....the team did not lose consecutive games at Miller Park until their 42nd home game, the longest streak to begin a season since the 1996 Yankees (46th game).....the Brewers went 40-41 (.494) at home last season, going 13-13-0 in series play.

BREWERS ON THE ROAD: The Brewers went 39-42 (.481) on the road this season, going 8-13-5 in series play.....after a 16-31 start, they went 23-11 on the road.....the team went 37-44 (.457) on the road last season, going 8-14-4 in series play.

BREWERS IN THE STANDINGS (182 days): The Brewers spent the following days alone or tied at each position in the NL Central standings: **FIRST:** 97, **SECOND:** 41, **THIRD:** 23, **FOURTH:** 8, **FIFTH:** 12, **SIXTH:** 1.....the team finished in first place, ahead of the second-place Cardinals by 6.0 games.....they were in first place every day from 7/27 through the end of the season and clinched the division on 9/23.

- In his first full season as a Major League closer tied for the National League lead in saves (46) with the Braves' Craig Kimbrel
- His 46 saves broke the single-season franchise record held by Francisco Cordero (44 in 2007)
- Joined Ken Sanders (1971) and Rollie Fingers (1981) as the only Brewers ever to lead their league in saves (Sanders and Fingers led majors)
- Had a 0.59 ERA over his last 30 appearances (30.1ip, 2er), including 10 consecutive scoreless appearances to end the season (11ip)
- Converted his last 43 save opportunities.....suffered his only blown saves on 3/31 at Cincinnati and 4/18 at Philadelphia
- His current saves streak is a franchise record, breaking the previous mark of 25 in a row by Doug Jones in 1997
